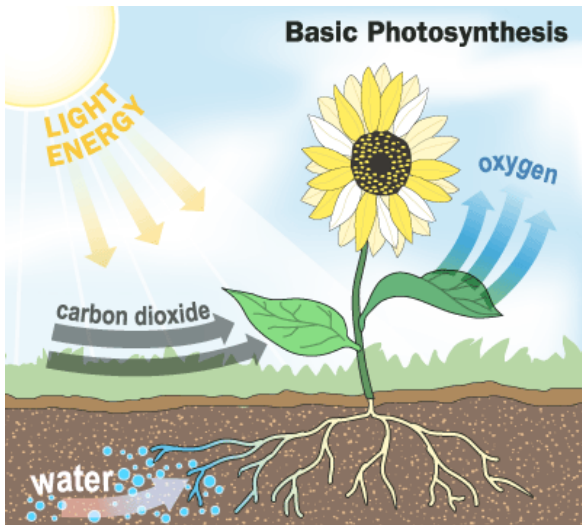

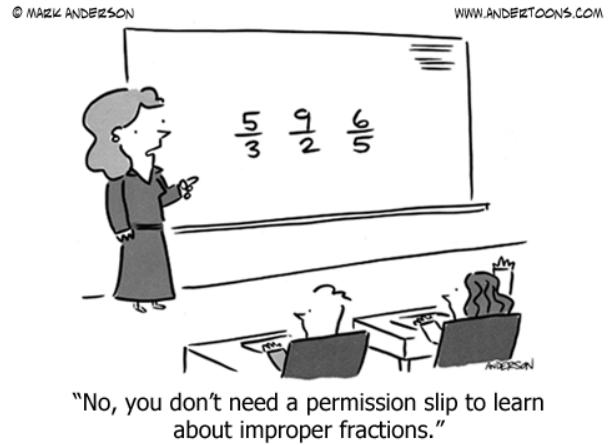
Pollination and Photosynthesis quiz Wednesday. Students should study their notes.
